10. Are you **in favor of** changing any laws? Which laws?
11. If a criminal **confesses to** doing a crime, should we punish them less?
12. Is there something that was difficult at first, but now you are **used to** doing?
13. We are going to have a party. Which part would you like to be **in charge of** organizing?
14. How do you **concentrate on** doing something? Do you have any strategies?
15. Do you **have an excuse for** sleeping in class? What is it?
